Dear Teachers and Principals

The OKC Philharmonic and OKC Orchestra League would like to invite your school to participate in *Sound Images*. **This program is presented by you, the teacher.**

*Sound Images* is a program designed to introduce students to the relationship between classical music and visual art through an art contest. Each visual arts specialist or 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade teacher will receive a classical music CD and curriculum materials outlining the program.

*Sound Images* will allow students to explore their imaginations and experience emotion and texture in music while also meeting Oklahoma's PASS initiatives. To begin, students will learn terms that are common to both visual art and music. After the students have mastered the terminology, they will begin listening to selections from the donated CD and "practicing" turning music into visual art. You will be given suggestions as to how to open the students' minds to this type of activity. After several practice sessions, the students will listen to the "contest" selection and create their artwork based on what they hear.

Students will be judged on the school level by the school, and art from the school winners will be sent to the Philharmonic to compete for an overall prize. Each student who participates in the program will receive a token of achievement. Overall winners will receive prizes, either tickets to the Discovery Concerts of the Philharmonic or MP3 players.

The deadline for artwork will be in the spring. Curriculum will be mailed in the fall.
